The Gateway Membership package also includes a \$50 discount voucher to spend at the Pro Shop on golf set essentials you will need for your game, a McLeod Country Golf Club shirt to look the part, two members' clinics to finetune your skills, and then discuss your game over a complimentary dinner for two and a bottle of wine at McLeod Country Golf Club's restaurant.

Gateway members won't have to play alone, with their package also including four free games of golf for a friend.

Those who join under this category for eight months pay only \$372.

McLeod Country Golf Club is located in the picturesque western suburbs at Mount Ommaney, approximately 15 minute drive from the city of Brisbane and is accessed easily by the Centenary Highway. As well as a superb 18 hole links golf course, The Westlake Room is the perfect venue for corporate functions.

McLeod hosts several prestigious events each year from Pro-Ams to two day corporate events. The club fields pennants teams in both male and female competitions, with beginner and junior groups strongly supported with special clinics scheduled weekly to cater for all levels of ability.
