LOCAL GOLF CLUB HITS FOR GREATER GOLFING OPPORTUNITIES IN SOUTH EAST WITH NEW PRO

McLeod Country Golf Club in Mt Ommaney is increasing golfing opportunities in the South East corner with the arrival of its new Pro, Randall Hollands-Smith.

Richard Harris, Head Professional at McLeod Pro Shop, appointed Mr Hollands-Smith alongside current Pro Chris Johnston, to improve golf for local junior golfers as well as club members.

"In addition to assisting Richard with his busy coaching schedule and managing the shop, one of my main objectives is to provide local support mechanisms and a pathway for golfers to learn the game, become a Club member, and then play representative golf and perhaps even professional golf on the national and international scene," he said.

However, it is not only junior golfers who would benefit, with Mr Hollands-Smith providing top quality coaching to local golfers, elite golfers and club members who are looking to improve their social game.

Prior to becoming McLeod Country Golf Club's newest Pro, Mr Hollands-Smith was a Coach with the A Game International Golfing Academy at nearby Brookwater Golf Club, as well as for the Jean Paul College Golf Program.

Mr Hollands-Smith was also a Coach at the Hills Golf Academy in Jimboomba for eleven years; a position he took while still playing professionally in national competitions.

Three seven-week golf clinics are scheduled to begin the week starting 27 April for golfers of all levels, from beginners who have never played golf to the more advanced member, who want to learn the techniques of the game from a professional golfer.

According to Mr Harris, the once a week hour-long clinics, which will run on Tuesday morning, Thursday morning (both at 9.30am) and Saturday morning (7am), are priced at \$115 for the entire clinic and focus on teaching all aspects of the game including driving, approach, short game and putting.

All clinics are available to all aspiring golfers, not just McLeod Country Golf Club members.

McLeod Country Golf Club has recently celebrated its 40th anniversary, and remains the first and only golf club fully administered by women in Australia for the enjoyment of all its players.

Today women, men and children make up the 1000-plus membership, enjoying the strong camaraderie and fellowship as well as a challenging game of golf on the 18-hole course.
